Land

Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the council. 'Land' excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not give me or my spouse/partner (alone or jointly with another) a right to occupy or to receive income.

Licences

Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the council for a month or longer.

Corporate Tenancies

Any tenancy where (to my knowledge)-

- (a) the landlord is the council; and
- (b) the tenant is a body that I my spouse/partner is a partner of or a director* of or has a beneficial interest in.

Securities

Any beneficial interest in securities* of a body where-

- (a) that body (to my knowledge) has a place of business or land around the council; and
- (b) either-
- (c) the total nominal value of the securities* exceeds £25,000 or one-hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or
- (d) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any class in which I or my spouse/partner has a beneficial interest which exceeds one-hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.
