Minutes of the Bramley Village Hall Management Committee Meeting 11th April 2025

Minutes: The draft minutes of the committee meeting of 17th January 2025 were agreed and signed by the Chairman.

Matters Arising:

Bookings Outlook: 2025

DL submitted a list of confirmed regular bookings from 1^{st} April to 30^{th} June 2025. The estimated revenue amounts to £6,683

DL pointed out that we had lost one regular booking but that we still have the 2 new bookings

Finance:

- i. Actual v budget to 31.03.25 (circulated) members noted the report.
- ii. **Payments and Receipts (circulated)** The reported amounts between 7th January and 31st March 2025 were reviewed and agreed.
- iii. Cash at bank 10th April 2025 £17,485.67

Maintenance:

- Vulcana heater filters DL & TC checked the filters in February
- TC advised that he would ask Nick Gravenell to look at the tiles missing on the roof.
- CM advised that the drain pipe near the main entrance needs fixing, TC will ask NG to look at that as well.

Refurbishment of the Hall

Following the support for the village hall in the ASDA online survey, the committee have identified 3 projects:

- Redecorate the internal walls on the hall at a cost of £9672, Nick Gravenell will work round the bookings to protect the hall income – An application has been submitted to Asda for funding.
- Improve the exterior lighting £1625 paid for by hall funds.
- Upgrade acoustics £15,764 3 quotes sourced and evaluated. The selected supplier
 will work around hall bookings to protect income. This supplier has also completed a
 similar project at Cranleigh Village Hall Application has been made to Your Fund
 Surrey for the funds.

A.O.B.

 The committee met on 7th February and identified a list of items that need repairing/improving in the Village Hall
 They will draw up a 5 year repair/maintenance plan.

- DE stated that she had received the asbestos report which showed no asbestos at the VH
- CM asked about the project to turn the stage into a storage area as suggested on February 7th. TC to obtain a quote for the work
- TC proposed a 5% pay rise for DL, which was unanimously approved by the committee
- CM stated that he had met with Bramley Helping Hand to discuss the food trolley in the village and the possibility of extending it a food bank open once a week. The committee discussed and agreed in principal the possibility of having it in the VH and using the VH for storage.
