## Bramley Parish Council Members' Code of Conduct

### Notification by Member of Pecuniary and Other Interests

I

Graham John Smith

a Member of Bramley Parish Council ("the Council")

GIVE NOTICE that I or my spouse or civil partner (or a person with whom I am living as husband and wife or as if we were civil partners<sup>1</sup>) have the following.

### Disclosable Pecuniary Interests<sup>2</sup>

#### Employment

Any employment, office, trade, profession, or vocation carried on for profit or gain. Any unpaid directorship.

Permission to Officiate in Diocese of Guildford  
Unpaid nominated director of the Radio Society of Great Britain from April 2026

#### Sponsorship

Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the council) made to the councillor during the previous 12-month period for expenses incurred by him/her in carrying out his/her duties as a councillor, or towards his/her election expenses. This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.

#### Contracts

Any contract made between me or my spouse/partner (or a firm in which that person is a partner or an incorporated body of which that person is a director\* or a body that that person has a beneficial interest in the securities of\*) and the council — (a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and (b) which has not been fully discharged.

#### Land

Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the council. 'Land' excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not give me or my spouse/partner (alone or jointly with another) a right to occupy or to receive income.
